To apply, submit the following materials to Kim Reimer (reimerk@udel.edu) by Thursday, March 26, 2020. Decisions will be announced by April 15, 2020.

A complete application should be submitted as a single PDF and include:

- 1. A 250-word description of the internship opportunity (where, duration, and duties) and how it relates to your professional development.
- 2. A budget request that clearly articulates financial need during internship term and outlines funds necessary to participate in the internship.
- 3. A one-page resume.

A letter of recommendation from a UD faculty member must be sent separately to Kim Reimer (reimerk@udel.edu) with the student's name in the subject line.

Successful applicants will be required to submit a brief report of the internship with up to three photos within thirty days of the conclusion of the internship (details to follow).
